

**Nonsuch and Wallington Second Stage Entrance Exam (NWSSEE)

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

You or your child must not enter the school site if you or they are displaying any symptoms of COVID-19

The main symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are:

- a high temperature – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back
- a new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

Travel to WHSG

Please note there is no on-site parking at Wallington High School for Girls, unless by prior arrangement for those with access needs. Parking enforcement will also be in place in some local residential roads. Please park considerately if you decide to drive to the school.

We advise arriving by public transport wherever possible. Buses 127, S4 and 463 stop right outside the school and we are only approximately a 20 minute walk from Wallington Station.

What will my daughter need to bring?

IMPORTANT A print out of the email giving their test session and candidate number. They will need to keep this with them.

- 2 HB or B pencils (for use in the Maths paper)
- A blue or black pen (for use in the English paper)
- A good quality rubber
- A pencil sharpener
- A ruler (optional)
- A bottle of water- no fizzy drinks
- A small snack (NO NUTS) for the break
- Optional: A book to read during the break (nothing to do with the exam)

Your child should **not** bring a mobile telephone, a smart watch or any other electronic or internet enabled devices, a calculator or calculator watch; any watch that beeps; any piece of stationery which displays times tables or other such information or a dictionary.

Please do not bring large bags or rucksacks as space in the exam venues is limited.

Staying safe and supporting the local community

- Candidates do not need to wear face coverings during the exam but may wear them if they wish

- Candidates should bring tissues and hand sanitiser
- Wear warm clothes as the windows will be open to aid ventilation
- Waterproof jacket with a hood to keep her warm and dry. Please check the weather forecast before starting your journey.

Arrival at WHSG

- ONLY ONE PARENT OR CARER WILL BE PERMITTED TO ACCOMPANY YOUR CHILD TO THE ENTRY POINT
- You must enter the school site by foot
- When you drop your child at the check in point you will be given a colour card indicating the zone for pick up after the test. YOU MUST BRING THIS WITH YOU WHEN COLLECTING YOUR CHILD
- Please make a swift exit to help ease congestion and to allow for social distancing
- Please follow all signs and instructions
- Access to the site will be denied before 8am

For session 1 (morning) please arrive no earlier than 08:00 and no later than 08:35

For session 2 (afternoon) please arrive no earlier than 12:00 and no later than 12:50

What will happen if my child becomes ill during the test?

- If your child informs an invigilator that she feels unwell and does not feel that she can carry on with the test, then a member of staff will collect her from the test venue
- Your child will be taken to our first aid area where a member of our first aid team will attend to them
- We will also contact you and ask that you come to the school to collect them
- In this instance we will allow vehicle access at the school entrance

Collecting your child after the test

- ONLY ONE PARENT OR CARER WILL BE PERMITTED ON SITE FOR COLLECTION
- Remember to bring the colour card given at drop off
- Access will be via the Woodcote Road service entrance
- As soon as you are reunited with your child please depart the site immediately
- Please ensure that you respect others and social distance when waiting
