You will have received an email giving your child's designated test centre, candidate number and an entrance to report to on arrival. Please print the email and provide your child with a copy to bring to the exam. This is needed on arrival.

WHAT TO DO ON ARRIVAL:

Please enter the school through the WOODMANSTERNE LANE entrance, unless otherwise indicated on your invitation.

ARRIVAL TIME

For the morning session Arrive between 8am and 8.30am. NO EARLIER

Testing will start at 9am

For the afternoon session Arrive between 12.30pm and 1pm. NO EARLIER

Testing will start at 1.30pm

We will have school staff and sixth formers on hand to receive your child and take them to their allocated seat in the school, so there should be minimal need for queueing on arrival. Should you have to wait for your child to be collected from you, please ensure that you observe social distancing. Please consider wearing a face covering.

Please note there is no parking on site unless by prior arrangement for those with access needs.

Will parents please leave promptly once their child has been collected and taken into the school.

End times are approximate. We would be grateful for your patience

Ten minutes or so before the end of your child's testing session, please arrive at your designated collection colour zone via the service entrance on Woodcote Road, remembering to maintain social distancing. Please depart promptly once you have been reunited with your son.

Candidates must bring the following items with them:-

- A <u>printout</u> of the email giving their candidate number and arrival point (don't expect to show us the number on your phone). This is very important. If you don't have access to a printer you can write the candidate number, entrance point and seat number on a piece of paper.
- 2 or more HB or B pencils
- A good quality rubber
- A book to read before the tests start and during the break. Make sure the book is one that your child really enjoys as they may be waiting in their test room for over an hour before the tests
- Hand sanitiser and tissues
- A jumper or fleece. Make sure that your child has enough warm layers as we will be keeping windows and doors open to ensure good ventilation.

They may also bring:-

A bottle of water – no fizzy drinks please – and a snack (no nuts).

A ruler to help them keep their place on the answer sheet.

Your child should not bring a mobile telephone or any other electronic device, a calculator or calculator watch; any watch that beeps; any piece of stationery which displays times tables or other such information or a dictionary.
