Planning:

Information about the animal.

Describe the animal.

Explain to your audience some of the reasons why most people like animals.

SAMPLE QUESTION

MY AMAZING DAY!

Imagine that you won a competition where your amazing prize was a day trip in one of the latest small spacecraft which takes passengers for a journey in to space.



Write the story of your day for your school's website.

Planning:

You must begin your story by writing:

'At last the day had come. I could not believe it as I arrived at the launch pad and saw the spacecraft waiting'.

SAMPLE QUESTION

You see the following headline in your local newspaper:

Another playing field sold for house building!

Your task is to write a letter to your local council to *persuade* them to not sell the playing field.
