Plan your journey



- There will be **no parking** on site or around the site
- Parking restrictions will be in place on the surrounding roads and parking attendants will be patrolling the area – please check the signs which will be in place
- Please be considerate of our local residents and businesses as they are part of our school community, e.g. please do not park across driveways

Plan your journey



- Wallington train Station is less than a mile from the school and approx. a 21 minute walk
- Buses 127, 463 and S4 stop outside of the school
- The local area will be **very** busy on the day of the exam, so please leave plenty of additional time to complete your journey

General information for drop off



- Only **one adult** per child and no siblings to minimise queuing
- Please arrive within the designated time slot
- Check the weather forecast and ensure you and your child are suitable dressed (you will be queuing outside for a period of time)
- Follow all instructions and requests from school representatives

Arrival



- Please enter the school via the **Woodmansterne Lane** entrance, unless otherwise indicated on your email invitation
- Marshalls will around the site to help guide you
- School staff and students will be on hand to receive your child and take them to their allocated seat

Arrival time



For the morning session:

Arrive between 8am and 8:30am

NO EARLIER

Gates open at 8am.

Gates close at 8:45am

For the afternoon session:

Arrive between 12:15pm and 12:45pm

NO EARLIER

Gates open at 12:15pm.

Gates close at 1pm

What candidates must bring



A print out of the email invitation, giving candidate number and seat location. A hard copy is essential as your child will need to take it into the room with them.

- A clear plastic pencil case or bag
- Two or more HB or B pencils
- A soft, good quality rubber
- A pencil sharpener
- A ruler to help them keep their place on the answer sheet
- A bottle of water (no fizzy drinks) in a clear plastic sports cap bottle and a small snack
(NO NUTS)
- for the break
- Waterproof jacket (ideally with a hood) and a jumper or fleece

What candidates may also bring



- A small packet of tissues
- A ruler to help them keep their place on the answer sheet
- A book to read before the tests start and during the break (this has nothing to do with the exam and should be a book your child enjoys to keep them occupied whilst waiting/in the break)

*Candidates are only allowed to bring a **small** bag, i.e. a tote bag or carrier bag – rucksacks are not permitted.*

All bags will be checked on arrival

Items which are **not** allowed



- Mobile telephones or any other electronic device
- A calculator or calculator watch
- Smart watch or a watch that beeps
- Any item of stationery which displays times tables or other such information
- A dictionary
- A rucksack or large bag
