## **Advice for parents**

You have been asked to collect your child from school as they are unwell. The school is unable to determine if the symptoms shown are related to Coronavirus.

 Please take your child home immediately and monitor the symptoms. The symptoms of Coronavirus are as below:

## HIGH TEMPERATURE OR NEW CONTINUOUS COUGH OR LOSS OF TASTE OR SMELL? No one in your household should leave home if any one person has symptoms. Find out how to get a test, and how long to isolate, at nhs.uk/coronavirus

- You should clarify if your child has coronavirus by getting a test done. If your child
  has a test for Coronavirus please inform the school. To find out how to get a test go

- Use the <u>attendance@wallingtongirls.org.uk</u> email address to inform Mrs Andrews daily that your daughter is absent from school in the usual way while you are waiting for results of the test.
- Please do not send your child to school until you have the results of the test. You
  must email the <u>results of the test taken</u> (whether negative or positive) to
  attendance@wallingtongirls.org.uk. Do not send your daughter back in to school
  unless you have received an email from Attendance in return stating this negative
  /positive test result has been received.
- If there is a sibling at the school please ask this person to self isolate until the test result has been received.
- If your child is well enough to work in this period of self isolation please inform Mrs Andrews at <a href="mailto:attendance@wallingtongirls.org.uk">attendance@wallingtongirls.org.uk</a> and the school will make arrangements for remote learning to take place.
