CONSENT TO USE OF GENERIC EMERGENCY SALBUTAMOL INHALER {ONLY FOR CHILDREN PRESCRIBED INHALERS}

From 1ST October 2014 the Human Medicines (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2014 allowed schools to purchase Salbutamol inhalers without prescription for use in emergencies. The Salbutamol would be administered via a spacer, which can then be sterilized, thus allowing multi-patient use from one inhaler.

Wallington High School for Girls has purchased an emergency kit which is kept in the first aid room, but **it** is still important that you continue to supply a named inhaler for your child, rather than relying on the emergency inhaler.

This emergency inhaler will only be:

- Used in an emergency with the prior written permission from a parent or guardian
- Given to children diagnosed with asthma and prescribed an inhaler
- Given to children who have been prescribed an inhaler as reliever medication.
