PREFECT OPPORTUNITIES



Are you serious about being a 'Leader' within our school community? Below are the leadership roles that you can apply for in Year 12. Please read this presentation carefully to understand more about the roles, expectations and the application process.



BEING A PREFECT



Your role is to act as an **ambassador** for the **whole school** and also to represent yourself and the Sixth Form in a positive light. Therefore at all times your attitude, appearance and conduct must be **exemplary**.

The role of Prefect requires **commitment** as you will be expected to attend events relevant to your Prefect role and you will also be expected to fulfil requests of the Senior Prefect Team or members of staff.



FORM PREFECT



Form Prefect:

(Applications open at the end of December)

You will be linked with a **form group** in the **lower school** and will undertake a number of tasks relating to this.

Requirements:

Attend and potentially lead a form time, attend year group assemblies and parents' evening for your year group; acting as a mentor and big sister; assisting the form tutor.

You will also be required to undertake a school duty (lunch duty once a fortnight).



SUBJECT PREFECT



Subject Prefect:

(Applications open at the end of December)

You will be allocated a subject area in the school and your role is to **represent** and **promote** that department across the school.

Requirements: Running help clinics and extra-curricular clubs; helping at open days and options events; running departmental house competitions. Some subject prefects will be invited to speak at WHSG does Ted Talks and contribute to subject publications.

You will also be required to undertake a school duty (break/lunch).



SENIOR PREFECT



The Senior Prefect team consist of 2 Head Girls, along with 10 Deputy Head Girls. This team lead both the Subject and Tutor Prefects, have regular meetings as a team along with leading and supporting the rest of the school.



SENIOR PREFECT



Deputy Head Girl (Charity)

You get to direct the school's charity efforts – from selecting a Sixth Form charity for the year, to coming up with a strategy for charity across the school.

You will lead a team of charity reps from years 7 to 11, meeting them regularly and assigning tasks to ensure a highly successful termly RAG week.

You will coordinate other charitable activities across the school and have the ability to give approval to events other students wish to run.



SENIOR PREFECT



Deputy Head Girl (Community)

You will manage several areas of responsibility which promote the value of fellowship across the school.

You will liaise with the House Leaders to promote the house system in the Sixth Form, including ensuring sixth form participation, organising the Sixth Form house activities and competitions.

You will also have an 'outreach' role, contacting alumni and keeping in touch with your year group and the school once you have left. You will also take the lead on the schools outreach to Primary Schools.

You will also take a lead on environment and sustainability

SENIOR PREFECT



Deputy Head Girl (Curriculum)

You will manage the subject prefects, assist with subject specific events, create and maintain a schedule for extra-curricular clubs and societies, promote clubs and societies across the school and motivate students to get involved.

You will manage the Presidents of the various student run societies and the process for setting up new societies. In addition you will take the lead on subject publications and WHSG does Ted Talks.



SENIOR PREFECT



Deputy Head Girl (EDI)

You will take the lead in promoting the schools Equality, Diversity and Inclusivity initiative.

Together you will manage the EDI lower school prefects and support whole school events that link to EDI such as BHM and PRIDE week. You will also manage the schools cultural calendar.

This role needs someone who is involved in school life, not afraid to speak up and passionate about EDI.



SENIOR PREFECT



Deputy Head Girl (Events and Marketing)

You will look to run and promote aspects of school life, specifically sixth form.

This includes running the Sixth Form instagram page and directing all Prefects on Open Evenings and events.

You will also support other students and staff in the organisation and running of whole school events.

This role needs someone who is involved in school life and has lots of school spirit. Someone that has creativity to promote and publish!



SENIOR PREFECT



Deputy Head Girl (Year - Pastoral)

You are the 'Head Girl' for your given year group and will coordinate projects and events for them, by working closely with the Head of Year.

You will also manage a group of Form Prefects, attend Parents' Evenings and all other related events for your year group, lead the Year Council and undertake other tasks as directed.

In the past Year Prefects have run options events, competition, wellbeing events and social activities.

This role needs someone with creativity and compassion.



HEAD GIRLS

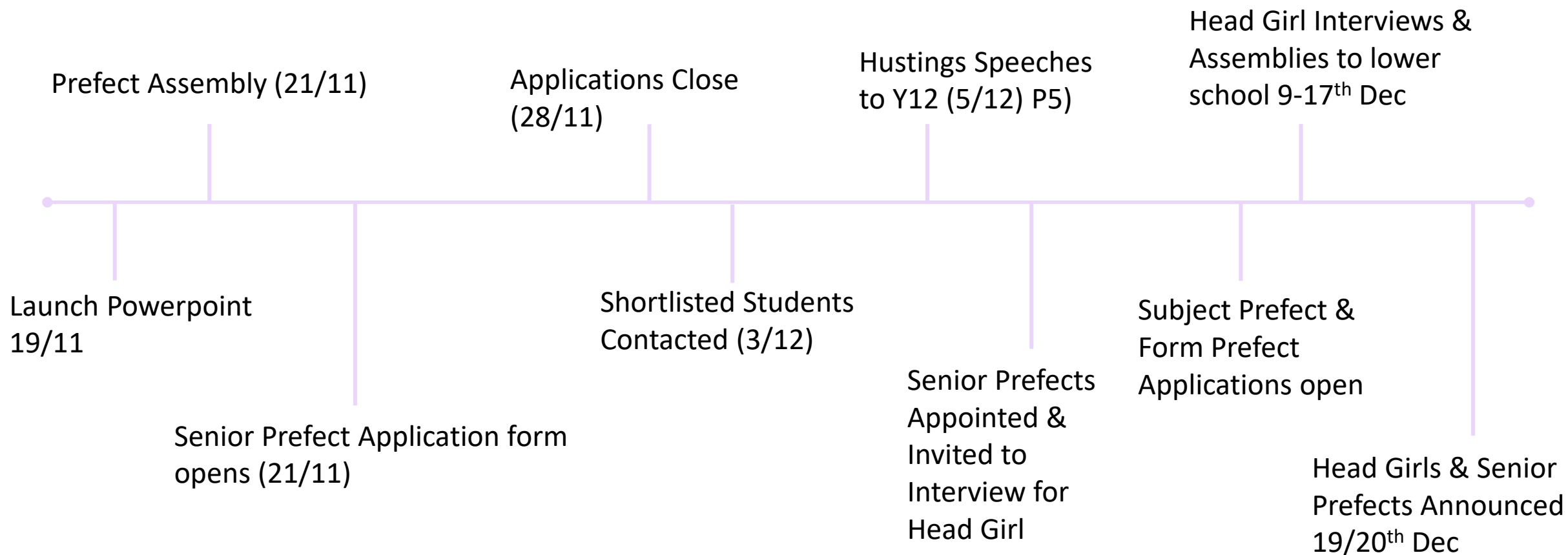


Head Girl:
