WHAT IS OUR SCHOOL FUND?

At Wallington High School for Girls, we are proud of our students' academic achievements, but we also recognise that an outstanding education extends far beyond examination results. Providing excellent facilities, enriching opportunities and an environment in which students can thrive is central to our vision for every young person.

The School Fund enables us to go beyond what can be provided through core school funding alone. It allows us to invest in learning environments, student facilities, enrichment opportunities and projects that enhance students' day-to-day experience of school.

Like many schools across the country, we continue to face increasing financial pressures and rising costs. The generosity of our parents, carers and alumnae enables us to make additional investments that directly benefit students and help us maintain the high standards and opportunities for which Wallington is known.

All contributions to the School Fund are entirely voluntary, and we are extremely grateful for every donation, whether regular or one-off. Collectively, these contributions help us continue investing in opportunities, facilities and experiences that benefit current and future Wallington students.

Over recent years, support from parents, carers and alumnae has enabled us to invest in a wide range of opportunities and improvements across the school, helping us provide facilities and experiences beyond those funded through our core budget.

FUNDING FUTURE PRIORITIES

This year we are seeking support across three key areas:

Science and Learning Environments

A key priority is the continued refurbishment and enhancement of our science laboratories, ensuring they provide modern, well-equipped environments that support practical investigation, inspire curiosity and reflect the high aspirations of our students.

We want students to benefit from an environment that supports both learning and wellbeing. This includes continuing to improve social spaces and facilities across the school, creating welcoming environments where students can study, collaborate, socialise and thrive.

Enrichment and Opportunity

WHAT YOUR SUPPORT DOES

Over recent years, School Fund donations have helped us to:

- Contribute towards the development of our sports hall, supporting sport and physical education across the school.

HOW MUCH TO DONATE

How much you choose to donate is entirely voluntary and a personal decision.

There is no expectation on families to contribute and every donation, regardless of size, is greatly appreciated.

Many families choose to support the School Fund through a regular monthly contribution. As an indication:

- £10 per month helps support enrichment activities and student opportunities.
- £25 per month helps contribute towards improvements to student facilities and learning environments.
- £50 per month helps support significant investments in school projects and student experience.

HOW TO DONATE

Donating money to the School Fund couldn't be easier. There are three different ways depending on your preference.

1. QUICK DONATION USING PAYDIT

Making a one-off donation is now easier than ever.

through Paydit. You can opt to gift aid your donation through the portal if you are a UK tax payer.

If you would like to make a regular contribution, standing orders can be set up quickly and securely using the details below.

2. STANDING ORDER

For **regular donations**, simply set up a *standing order* in your online banking app using the same details:

MAKE YOUR DONATION GO FURTHER WITH GIFT AID

If you are a UK taxpayer, Gift Aid increases the value of your donation by 25% at no

additional cost to you.

As a member of the Girls' Learning Trust, Wallington High School for Girls has the same status as a charity. Gift Aid allows UK charities to claim back the basic rate tax already paid on donations by the donor. This means we can claim back from the government on your behalf 25p for every £1 donated, boosting the value of the donation by a quarter.

To enable us to claim Gift Aid, you need to:

- Be a UK taxpayer (Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax).
- Have paid at least as much in UK tax in that tax year as the amount of Gift Aid we will claim.
- Complete the Gift Aid declaration via PaydIT or on our separate form by clicking on this link: [Gift Aid Declaration](#).

Gift Aid does not cost you anything extra, but it makes your donation go further.
